Supporting the Entrepreneurship Journey (SEJ)

Why “SEJ” Training Course for Youth Workers?

Since the last years in Europe, the promotion of **entrepreneurship in youth work** is a priority. Despite having good ideas, many young people don't know the necessary tools to develop their entrepreneurial social projects; they need to be supported and accompanied to put in practice these projects. It has also been found that many workers in the field of youth are well prepared to motivate these youngsters but they are not sufficiently prepared to support the implementation of the projects.

That's why, in this TC, the participants will:

- Experiment in themselves the process of starting an entrepreneurial project.
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- Analyze the key factors about motivation and the difficulties of the process they will experience.
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- Empower themselves and increase their competences to be able to support the young people they are working with in these processes.

During this project we will work with a wide spectrum of projects, from social, local, entrepreneurial projects to international projects, especially in the field of the Erasmus + programme.

Participants

Addressed to **Youth leaders and Youth workers** willing to enhance their competences in the field of accompanying and supporting social entrepreneurship and able to **communicate and work in English fluently.**

Our objectives

- a) To give the opportunity to participants to learn **key elements** and concepts of being entrepreneurial and discover how to support **social entrepreneurship**.
- b) To get to know the entrepreneurial competences and the useful tool **EntreComp** and its application in the development of projects, trainings and specially in their daily work with youngsters.
- c) To promote the use of **Erasmus + projects and European Solidarity Corps projects**, as a tool for development of entrepreneurial competences in an transnational level.
- d) To let participants identify their needs and next steps to **improve their competences** accompanying and supporting young entrepreneurs.
- e) To focus on the transfer part, on the way participants will **connect** the training course and their daily work with youngsters.
- f) **To create a network** that will allow support, networking, cooperation and sharing of experiences among participants.



Approach & Methodology:

- **Mix of theoretical inputs combined with practical exercises to allow the comprehension of the concepts and tools.**
- **Working with different learning methods based on non-formal education; like self-directed learning methods, reflection, peer to peer learning... to allow the transfer of the learning into different situations and into their reality.**
- **Using the existing resources in the TC: participants, trainers and real social entrepreneurial examples that we will get to know during the TC.**

Financial conditions

This project is financed by the **Erasmus + Programme**, under the action: **Key Action 1 - Mobility** project for young people and youth workers.

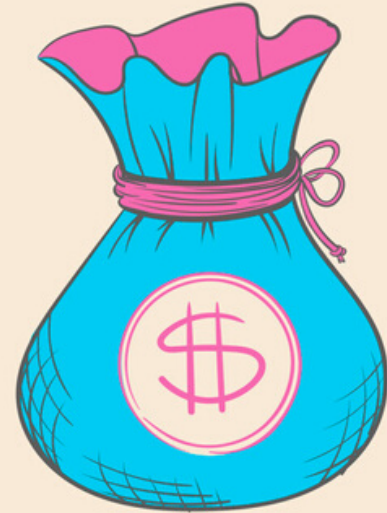
The **participants that you as partner, select for this training course** will receive accommodation, meals and local transport during the seminar.

The **travel should be arranged by the participants**, and it will be covered by the Erasmus + programme, following the rules defined by this programme (trip covered until a fix quantity, provided in tables according to the distance between the city of the partner organisation and the venue in Madrid; distance calculated, one way, with:

There's no participation fee.



The travel should be arranged by the participants or the organizations, and it will be covered by the **Erasmus + programme**, following the rules defined by this programme (and showed in the list in page 6).

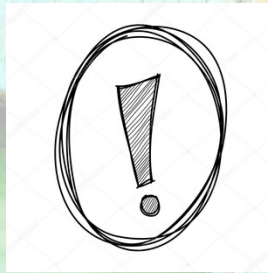
If you exceed the travel budget, you will have to pay the difference. The cheaper you get the trip, the better.

We will reimburse you the money back (please, consider that reimbursement will be done in EURO regardless the mentioned currency in tickets, receipts and invoices. All tickets purchased in any currency other than EURO will be converted and calculated according to the exchange rate signed within the month between the hosting NGO and Spanish National Agency).

Reimbursement will be done through bank transfer after the Training Course if all the project conditions and rules have been followed.

To receive reimbursement, you need to provide us all the original copies of transportation modes (plane, train or bus) that are used during your trip from departure city to Madrid. These include:

- o Receipts
- o Boarding passes
- o Tickets
- o Invoices



We can't reimburse:

- o Travel costs without these original documents
- o Taxi and private transportation (Taxi, BlaBla Car...)

Participants can arrive or departure **2 days before and/or after the training course**. Let us know the travel details and ask before buying tickets.

We would like you to know that it is not easy at all to arrive for participants themselves to the hosting place due to transport combination, so in order to get the tickets to come to Madrid, we will have to ask them to arrive before **15:30-16:00 to the airport on the 21st of April and departure must be after 13 p.m. on the 27th of April (to take into consideration before buying the tickets).**

We will provide a transfer and it is important for everybody to arrive on time.

The venue



We will be staying in Los Batanes hostel in **Rascafría, Madrid**, one hour and a half far away from Madrid city centre.
