

Call for participants: TC "Cross-sectorial cooperation: Think globally act locally"

International training course "Cross-sectorial cooperation: Think globally act locally " will gather 30 participants from Slovenia, Lithuania, Latvia, Italy, Poland, and Croatia, **from 9th to 17th of August, 2019 in Slovenia**. The project will create a learning space to develop a network of cross-sectorial cooperation and improve the effectiveness of youth policy implementation at the local level.

The project will provide a space for the exchange of information on the situation of young people and examples of good practices in implementing youth policy in different European countries. During the training course, youth coordinators, municipal experts for youth issues (public servants) and youth representatives, youth leaders and youth workers will improve their competencies in the following areas: cross-sectorial cooperation, development of regional youth policy, exploring the position of young people, actively involving young people in decision-making, advocacy and effective representation; took note of the national and European youth policy frameworks and the opportunities offered by the latter; they will expand their social network at the international level and learn how to build alliances; they will improve their communication and advocacy skills; the ability to speak and speak in the media. They will share their experiences and learn either individually or in a group; they will create tools / tools that could bring the necessary changes to improve youth policy in individual municipalities.

Profile of participants:

Youth workers, youth leaders, municipal coordinators of the youth field, experts working with young people in other institutions at the municipal level (local level).

Participants will:

1. Understand the importance of cross-sectorial cooperation in the field of youth policy.
2. Share and develop cross-sectorial cooperation tools and exchange examples of good practices from different European countries.
3. Learn to use tools to analyse the situation of young people at local level and to draw up plans to improve youth policy.

4. Have a space for the development of future activities / projects at local and international level with the aim of promoting cooperation in the field of youth policy and improving the situation of young people. Promotion of the Erasmus + program.
5. Create a manual on cross-sectoral cooperation in the field of youth policy.
6. Have a space for the development of future Erasmus + projects and ensure the quality of projects by developing a common understanding of the quality criteria for youth projects: non-formal education.

Methodology:

The trainer's team will use maximum variety and creativity of the methods during the training course in order to ensure that participants can apply those methods back in their organizations and when working with young people in local communities.
